



**Decision of the Director 16/2016/DIR**

**on the Offer of Framework Partnerships to implement CEPOL training  
activities and learning products in 2017 -2020**

**Adopted by the Director**

**on 29 April 2016**

THE DIRECTOR,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2015/2219 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 November 2015 on the European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training (CEPOL) and replacing and repealing Council Decision 2005/681/JHA and in particular Article 3 (3) and (4) and Article 14 (5) e thereof;

Having regard to Article 121 of the Regulation No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union (Financial Regulation),

Having regard Article 178 of the Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1268/2012 of 29 October 2012 on the rules of application of Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union

Having regard to Decision 33-2015-GB of 17 November 2015 on Adopting the Single Programming Document - YEARS 2016-2018,

Having regard on the Report on "Review of Framework Partnership Applications 2017\_2020" with regard to the Call for Framework Partners to implement CEPOL training activities and learning products in 2017 -2020

Whereas "a call for new Framework Partners (FP) 2017-2020 will be launched in 2016".

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS

Article 1

Framework Partnerships are offered to all of the organisations indicated in annex I.

Article 2

Framework Partnerships are offered to the French National Police College (ENSP), Hellenic Police Academy, State Police College of Latvia and the Police Department under the Ministry of the Interior of the Republic of Lithuania despite the delayed submission of their application forms due to the fact that these institutions do comply with the factual conditions set by the Call for Framework Partners and play crucial role in their national level of law enforcement training.

### Article 3

In accordance with Articles 1 and 2 and Article 4a(1) of Protocol No 21 on the position of the United Kingdom and Ireland in respect of the area of freedom, security and justice, annexed to the TEU and to the TFEU, and without prejudice to Article 4 of that Protocol the United Kingdom and Ireland are not bound by or subject to the application of the new CEPOL regulation.

As a consequence of the position of the United Kingdom and Ireland Framework Partnerships are not offered to the Garda College - Ireland's National Police Services, Canterbury Christ Church University, Scottish Police Authority, Bath Spa University and the Liverpool John Moores University (annex II).

In case the United Kingdom or Ireland participation in the CEPOL regulation is confirmed in the future Framework Partnership Agreements shall be offered to the respective applicant(s).

### Article 4

Framework Partnership is not offered to COESPU - Italian Carabinieri Corps - Center of Excellence for Stability Police Units, Carabinieri Officers Academy, Arquebus Solutions Ltd due to ineligibility (annex III).

### Article 5

This Decision shall take effect on the day of its signature.
