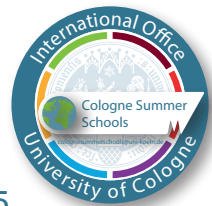


Cologne Summer School on Environmental Studies

The idea of the program is to understand and solve environmental problems and research environmental issues by fostering multidisciplinary and multi-national education and thinking. As the global aspects of human actions and environmental problems such as the sustainability of big cities become more important, we exclusively invite students from our partner institutions

Costs
