



Francisco Miguel Gouveia Pinto Proença Garcia is a LTC in the Portuguese Army. He graduated from Military Academy in 1991. He took his PhD in Contemporary History at the Oporto University in 2001. He had his Agregation (same as the German Habilitation) at the Portuguese Catholic University in 2008. He took the Staff Course at the Portuguese Joint War College in 2006.
